Child in mainstream school displaying complex and challenging behaviour. Concerns raised over social, emotional and mental health skills.

Assess – Plan – Do Review

Child continues to struggle

Child makes progress – no further actions.

Stepping Stones Outreach team specialist teacher visit for 1 full day to the school, observe, collate information and provide a detailed report with suggested strategies.

(No Charge until April 2019)

(April Estimation = £480 - £500)

Implement strategies, monitor the impact, and review progress

Child continues to struggle

Child makes progress – no further actions.

Mainstream school wish to commission support – Bespoke to the child and school needs.

Stepping Stones deliver over a period of 6 weeks.

(Approx. £450 - £480)

Implement strategies, monitor the impact, and review progress. Ensure Educational Psychology and SEND involvement. Through TAF / CAF Process

Child continues to struggle

Child makes progress – no further actions.

Seek parental permission for case to be discussed at Stepping Stones Multi Agency Planning Meeting.

MAP meeting held every half term, all paperwork and evidence to be submitted at the latest of 1 week prior to placement

Mainstream school to complete request for placement documentation and send to diane.sheron@steppingstones.lancs.sch.uk head@steppingstones.lancs.sch.uk

1 week prior to panel date.

Multi-agency pupil planning meeting held.

Placement declined.

Panel will make recommendations to review at next panel.

1 term placement agreed

Current Cost £1,850

To be reviewed

Exit strategy and long-term plans will be put in place.

The Multi Agency Panel will meet on a half-termly basis. This tends to be in the second to last week.
