











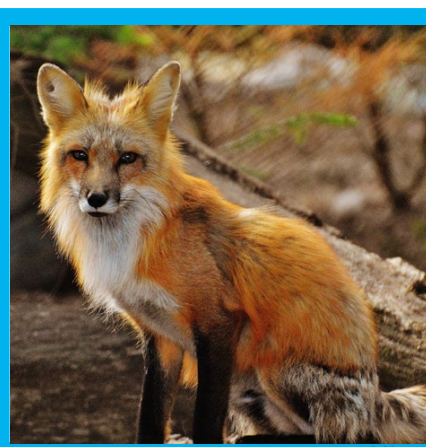
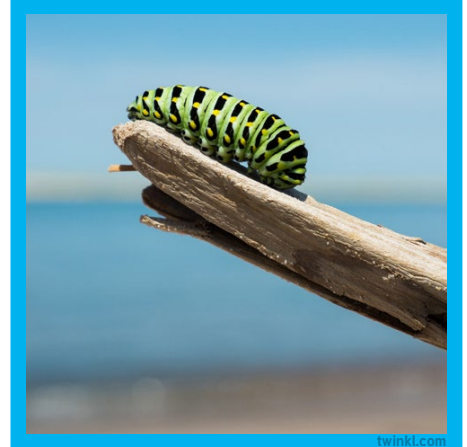
Stepping Stones Choice Board - FOUNDATION

Each day complete one task from this choice board. If you want to complete additional tasks you can explore other areas of Purple Mash.			
Science  Remember to keep monitoring the growth of your strawberry plant and fill out the growth chart.	Don't Forget ... The children have access to a Yumu Charanga account to develop their music skills. Each child has their own login and password. They also have access to their Purple Mash accounts for developing their computing skills. 		
Science Food Chains – cut and stick the photocards to build four different food chains.  <i>What is a food chain? The term food chain describes the order in which living things, depend on each other for food. Most food chains start with a living thing that makes their own food, such as plants. Scientists call them producers. The middle of a food chain has the prey (the things that eat the producers) and the end of the food chain has the predators (the things that eat the prey!)</i>	Craft Pipecleaner animals – there are some ideas here, lots more ideas on a webssearch or you can let your imagination run wild and invent an animal! I've included some funky pipecleaners and some kooky eye stickers in your learning packs. 		
DT A bit of graphic design today – I want you to invent a new zoo or safari park and design a new logo for it. You can use a painting program on a computer if you want to, or you can just draw it and colour it in on paper. 	DT Design an enclosure for a zoo animal. What kind of habitat will it need to live in? 		
Art Drawing animals using step by step guides. I've included some in your learning packs that I've found in a web search. If there is a specific animal you want to draw though, a quick web search will usually find you a step by step guide for your chosen animal. 	Challenge! Look at the creature comforts videos that show animals talking about their lives. Could you make a stop-motion animation about an animal kept in a zoo?
