
### A Peek At What We Are Learning



English

Our English unit this half term will be based on the book 'Peril at the Bake Off' by Ruth Quayle which is the perfect mix of humour and mystery genre. During the unit, the children will learn an array of grammar skills: conjunctions of time, adverbs of manner, imperative verbs and how to correctly punctuate direct speech. They will write an instruction text- where the children get to make delicious cakes and then write a recipe for them. They will also write a mystery narrative.

Post SATs math will be project work where the children can work in groups with their business partners to plan, cost and market a theme park of their design.

In science, we will be investigating electricity. The children will be constructing simple series circuits and drawing them using scientific symbols. They will conduct investigations to determine how the voltage in a circuit affects the brightness of a bulb.

We will be studying the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings in history this half term, and using our computing skills to create an online questionnaire for our enterprise project.. Morecambe Football Club will also be coming in to deliver PE on a Friday afternoon.
