Neurodiversity Celebration Week takes place annually in March. It was founded in 2018 to highlight the importance of a balanced view of neurodiversity which recognises the strengths and talents of neurodivergent people.

Approximately 15 - 20% of the population are neurodivergent. Neurodiversity is considered an umbrella term to describe differences of thinking styles such as Dyslexia, DCD also known as Dyspraxia, Dyscalculia, Autism and ADHD.
