A Peek At What We Are Learning



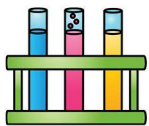
SATs

As you may be aware, some Year 6 pupils will sit the Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) in May. SATs will start on Monday 11th May and will last until Thursday 14th May. During the course of the week, your child will be completing a Reading, two SPAG, Arithmetic, and two Reasoning papers.



English

Using The Iron Man book by Ted Hughes, children will explore settings and characters through roleplay. Learn to write cohesively using adverbials and conjunctions. Use expanded noun phrases to create vivid descriptions. Put it all together to write a new story about the Iron Man.



Science

During science this half term, children will develop a deeper understanding of how the human body works by learning about the circulatory system and its role in maintaining the body's health. They will take part in an investigation to explore how different types of physical activity affect heart rate.



Topics

In Geography, children will learn about the biomes and ecosystems in the UK. They will plan fieldwork to be conducted in a local woodland ecosystem, investigating the amount and variety of trees, plants and animals. In art the children will be creating media land and city scapes.
