

Free Support Service

The Local Authority fund Stepping Stones' Support Service so we are able to offer this service free to schools in District 1, 2 and 4.

The Support Service provides guidance and advice for children presenting challenging behaviour and social, emotional and mental health needs in schools.

Support includes:

Support Packages

We deliver tailored programmes of support to promote positive behaviour management strategies, mental health and to champion inclusive practice. We have a track record of re-engaging excluded and at-risk learners.

Bronze Package (Individual Pupil): £650

Specialist Teacher Input for individual pupils

An OST specialist teacher will complete an observation and meet with key staff and the child's parents. They will provide advice through a report and action plan (including provision of resources where applicable). If the child has an **Education & Health Care Plan** then the action plan will use the EHC outcomes broken down into short term targets. For children in EYFS the action plan can be tailored to the Early Learning Goals. The package is typically: a visit where information is gathered; a written report and action plan with recommendations and resources if needed; delivery of the report, which may be on Teams, to staff and parents; followed by a review, which may be on Teams, 6 weeks later. This can be part of the Assess, Plan, Do, Review process.

Bronze Package (Whole Class): £700

Specialist Teacher Input for whole classes

An OST specialist teacher will complete an observation and meet with key staff. They will provide advice through a report and action plan (including provision of resources where applicable). For children in EYFS the action plan can be tailored to the Early Learning Goals. Email correspondence will take place every two weeks during the 6 weeks of support between the specialist teacher and the class teacher. The package is typically: a visit where information is gathered; a written report and action plan with recommendations and resources if needed; delivery of the report, which may be on Teams, to staff; followed by a review, which may be on Teams, 6 weeks later.

Silver Package (Individual Pupil): £1200

Specialist Teacher Input for individual pupils

This package includes all of the Bronze package **plus** an extra 6 hours of direct support to the pupil and the key adults supporting them. This support is delivered by an OST specialist teacher and is tailored to each individual pupil's needs.

Silver Top Up Package: £550**Specialist Teacher Input for individual pupils**

This package may be commissioned following a Bronze Package if a school feels they need further support. Following the review meeting, targets where further support is needed will be decided on and then 6 hours of direct support to the pupil and the key adults supporting them will take place. This support is delivered by an OST specialist teacher.

Emotional Regulation Group Package: £920**Specialist Teacher Input for a small group intervention**

Following an initial meeting with SLT to set target focus areas, an OST specialist teacher will provide 6 hours of weekly direct support to a small group of pupils. A follow up meeting will take place to review pupil's progress. This package is available as a KS1 or a KS2 package. The support will be for up to 6 pupils. A member of staff from the school will need to be present during the weekly sessions.

Sensory Regulation Support Package: £500**Specialist Teacher Input for individual pupils (or whole classes)**

This support package will help identify sensory likes and dislikes and possible barriers to learning. Strategies will be identified that will help children to regulate and be ready to learn. The package consists of an observation, a bespoke sensory preferences and strategies report and a bespoke sensory lifestyle plan, a report delivery meeting and a 6 week review meeting. The two meetings may take place on Teams.

This package cannot be used to diagnose and/or support children with Sensory Processing Disorder.

Consultancy Hours: £100 per hour

Consultancy hours can be commissioned for additional services following discussion with the Outreach Support Team Manager.
