A Peek At What We Are Learning



English



Our English unit this half term will be based on 'Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx' by Joe Todd Stanton which is a graphic novel based on Ancient Egypt. The children will learn about conjunctions, adverbs, commands, commas, figurative language, expanded noun phrases and direct speech. Each grammar focus paves the pathway to three extended pieces of writing: instructional writing, a quest narrative and a play script.



Math

The maths topics we will focus on this half term are place value, addition and subtraction, statistics, geometry (angles) and geometry and measures.



Science

In science, we will be investigating forces. Pupils will revisit gravity and friction, then extend their understanding to include air resistance, water resistance and the role of surface texture and shape. They will plan and carry out various forms of testing, analyse results to identify patterns and draw conclusions



Topics

We will be studying Ancient Egypt in history this half term, learning all about pyramids, Pharaohs, the Nile and mummification! Morecambe Football Club will also be coming in to deliver PE on a Friday afternoon.
